Our growing national and international business operations are managed from our corporate headquarters in Virginia Beach, Virginia. Over the last 15 years, Linxx has offered a wide range of educational, training, professional, and program management services around the world. We support all branches of the Department of Defense (DoD); the intelligence community; U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and other federal, state, and local agencies.

Capabilities Summary

Our service offerings are divided into two categories: Education and Training Services and Professional Services.

Education and Training Services

Linxx delivers the full spectrum of human developmental experience. We use qualified education and training professionals to teach existing programs of instruction, or develop new curriculum and materials to meet our customer's specific needs. We work with our customers to analyze their needs, identify gaps, and create educational or training solutions that meet their stated requirements in a way that supports their schedule and budget.

Education

We specialize in professional military education, providing all levels of noncommissioned officer and officer instruction. Examples of courses we have designed and delivered include the following: Strategic Theory and Strategic Design, Understanding the Operational Level of War, Staff Structure and Staff Operations, Joint Operations, Operational and Tactical Leadership, Military Mission Planning Process, Understanding Irregular Warfare, Understanding Foreign Internal Defense (FID), Understanding Unconventional Warfare, Military Doctrine Development, Mission-essential Task List Development, Military Writing, Presentation Skills, Military PowerPoint Design, Negotiation Skills, Military Logistics, Special Operations Mission Planning, Mobility Planning, and Force Protection Operations (Mobile and Static). Linxx can provide leadership assessments and customized leadership education based on our customer's requirements.

Training

Linxx currently provides tactical training to the U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM), Joint Special Operations Command (JSOC), all components of the Navy Expeditionary Combat Command (NECC), and other military organizations, as well as federal agencies. Examples of courses we have designed and delivered include the following: Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced Tactical Movement; Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced Small Arms Training; Maritime Tactical Movement; Small-unit Tactics; Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced On-road and Off-road Driving, Motorcade and Convoy Tactics, Urban Patrolling and Urban Tactics, and Countersurveillance. Linxx curriculum developers and instructors work from the commander's intent and mission statement to ensure the final training result meets all requirements. We deliver training services to allied personnel as required and authorized in support of U.S. government contracts. When teaching allied students, we take into account cultural and language barriers that may impact the learning process. We also can train the trainer to allow transfer of leadership and training management responsibility over time.

Professional Services

Linxx recruits, screens, trains, and deploys a wide range of professional talent that delivers exceptional value to our customers. We leverage internal processes that include recruiting software and talent database management tools to seek out and find the best personnel for our customers. We are adept at preparing selected personnel for their contract support assignments. Special Studies

Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. Wins Defensive Combat Operations Training Contract (January 8, 2010)

Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. has been awarded a contract to provide Naval Beach Group personnel with a ten-day, defensive combat operations training course. Linxx has conducted several pilot versions of this dynamic curriculum for Naval Beach Group units since June of 2009. The course consists of tactical movement, perimeter defense, small arms proficiency, mission planning, and practical field exercises.

Specifically, Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. covers operational command and control, training and readiness, organizational leadership, material craft and equipment suitability, logistics, maintenance sustainability, professional military education, and maritime facilities infrastructure.

Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. Wins New U.S. Navy Training Contract (September 17, 2009)

Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. was awarded the Maritime Civil Affairs and Security Training (MCAST) Command High-threat Instructor Training contract. The company will provide the MCAST mobile training teams with comprehensive tactical training courses designed to ensure U.S. Navy personnel assigned overseas in high-risk areas are capable of conducting foreign unit training for military, civil, and security personnel safely within partner nation countries worldwide.

Federal Emergency Management Agency Awards Contract to PaTH Joint Venture (July 10, 2009)

The Federal Emergency Management Agency has awarded a contract to Partnership for Temporary Housing, LLC (PaTH) to provide temporary housing and emergency response services for disaster victims. Linxx Global Solutions, Inc. is a partner in the PaTH Joint Venture, providing incident command post and disaster site survey and assessment support. The indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity Individual Assistance-Technical Assistance Contract III has a potential value of \$375 million over the one-year base period and four 1-year option periods.
